New South Wales Golf Club Policy - Dress Code



At The New South Wales Golf Club, we value a welcoming and respectful environment that balances professionalism with comfort for Members, guests, and staff. The following guidelines outline acceptable attire to ensure everyone enjoys a positive experience.

General Guidelines

- Dress code details are available on the Club's website.
- Members are responsible for their guests and are expected to follow the dress code. Staff decisions regarding appropriateness are final and should be respected.
- Golfers not in compliance should visit the locker room to change. If collecting clubs, please contact the Golf Shop to have them placed on the bag stand in the car park.

Golf Course & Practice Facilities

Men

- Golf-specific or similar styles are required.
- Shirts must have collars or roll collars and be tucked in unless designed otherwise.
- Tailored trousers or shorts with belts are mandatory.
- Socks should be white unless wearing black shoes, which may be paired with black socks. Ankle socks are permitted
- Soft-spiked, golf-specific shoes are required.

Women

- Golf-specific apparel that is neat and well-maintained is required.
- Collared tops designed to be worn untucked must be golf appropriate.
- Soft-spiked, golf-specific shoes are required

Clubhouse

Men & Women

- Clean, dry golf attire or smart casual wear is appropriate.
- Tailored shirts designed to be untucked may be worn, subject to staff approval.
- Shoes designed to be worn without socks, such as moccasins or boat shoes, are acceptable.
- Fancy dress attire may be permitted for specific occasions.
- Neat golfing attire or smart casual wear is appropriate.

Not Permitted (Golf Course & Clubhouse)

- Clothing deemed inappropriate by staff.
- Overt advertising logos (except golfing brands or manufacturer labels).
- Hats, visors, or caps in the Clubhouse.
- Backward-worn caps or visors at any time.
- Cargo pants, denim, tracksuits, or drawstring pants.
- T-shirts, hoodies, singlets.
- Open sandals, trainers, or non-golf-specific footwear.
- Tight fitting Athleisure wear, compression tights, or gym clothes
