At The New South Wales Golf Club, we value a welcoming and respectful environment that balances professionalism with comfort for Members, guests, and staff.

The following guidelines outline acceptable use of electronic equipment to ensure everyone enjoys a positive experience.

General Guidelines

- Mobile phones should only be used for making phone calls in the car park.
- Silent applications on mobile phones, tablets, and laptops are permitted but must be used discreetly without disturbing others.
- Laptops are to be used primarily in the designated business centre
- Video calls should be conducted in private meeting rooms to avoid disturbing other members.
- Headphones should be used when listening to audio on electronic devices to maintain a quiet environment.
- All electronic devices should be switched to silent mode in common areas such as the lounge and dining areas.
